what is household hazardous waste?

Household hazardous waste is any product labeled: toxic, poison, corrosive, flammable, combustible, or irritant that is disposed of.

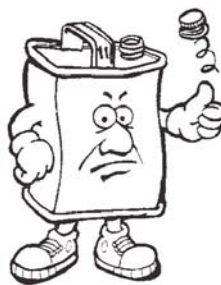

how to prepare your materials

- Seal the material in its original container, if possible.
- Wrap glass bottles in a cloth, newspaper, or other packaging material to prevent breakage.
- Place material in a cardboard box.
- Place cardboard box either in the trunk of the car or in the bed of a pickup truck.
- Keep material away from passengers.
