REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR CITY OF PINEVILLE, LOUISIANA DISASTER DEBRIS REMOVAL & DISPOSAL

Additional RFP Questions and Responses, as of September 7, 2020 at 11:30 am CST:

1. Section 11 of the Special Conditions requires the Contractor to provide daily progress reports to the Monitor within 24 hrs. containing:
 1. Total quantity of debris collected by type
 2. Maps of the geographical areas addressed

While it would not be impossible for a Contractor to produce this data, standard practice is for the Monitoring Firm to produce this data. Most Monitoring Firms that use ADMS systems can provide the data requested above on a daily basis if not "real time." We are not aware of any Contractor in our Industry that possesses ADMS capability, therefore the collection contractor would have to manually produce the items above.

Please consider using the reports produced by the chosen Monitoring Firm.

An Amendment is being issued to clarify that the Daily Progress Reports must be generated in conjunction with the Debris Monitor.

2. Section C of Evaluation and Contract Award states that the award will be made to one or more Proposers.

Does the Parish anticipate activating more than one Contractor?

The City is independent of the Parish and intends to review the proposals before making a decision at time of award as to whether it will use one or more contractors.
